We strive to continue to act with compassion and inclusion in our daily experiences. We do this by living out our school values;

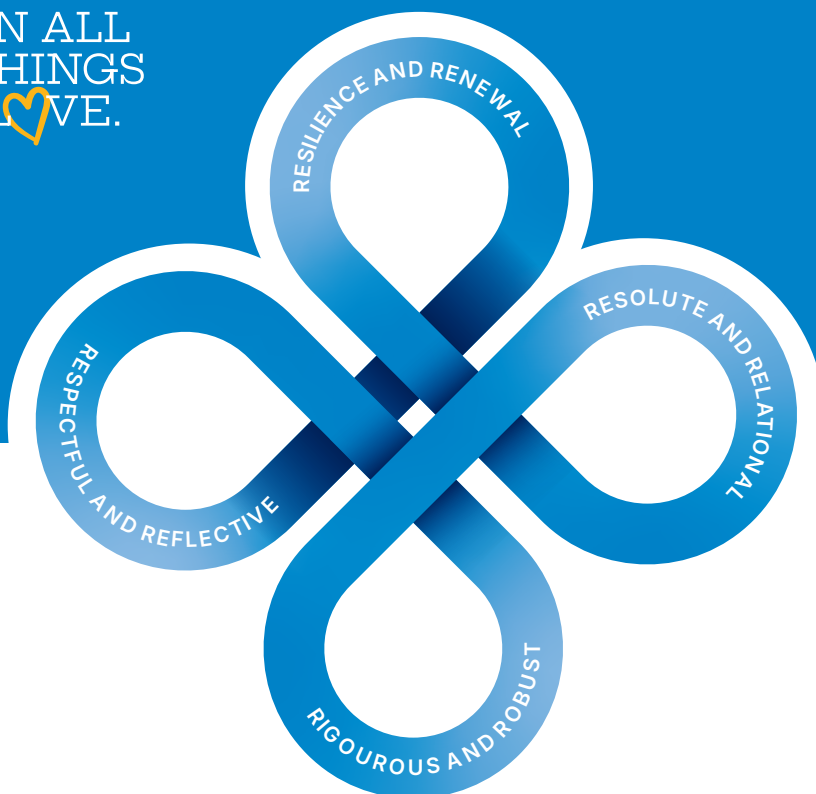
